【修正公告】國立東華大學管理學院辦理外籍生（在校生）申請東華獎學金審查原則
【Correction Announcement】 Review Principles for Foreign Students (Current Students)
Applying for the National Dong Hwa University Scholarship by the College of Management

1. 自 114 學年度第 1 學期起，外籍學生（在校生）如欲申請東華獎學金，應於申請前按校方規定完成註冊及第一期繳費或申請緩繳手續。

Starting from the 1st semester of the Academic Year 2025, international students (current students) who wish to apply for the National Dong Hwa University Scholarship must complete registration and pay the first installment of tuition fees or apply for a deferred payment in accordance with the university's regulations before submitting their application.

2. 如經管理學院國際事務委員會審查符合給獎資格但 OIA 審查備註為「未完成註冊繳費手續，請院系審慎考量獎學金」者，獎學金一律最高僅給 C。

If the Committee of International Affairs, College of Management, reviews and confirms that the applicant meets the scholarship eligibility criteria, but the OIA review notes indicate "Incomplete registration and payment procedures, please carefully consider the scholarship allocation," the maximum scholarship awarded shall be limited to Category C.

3. 若遲至管理學院國際事務委員會審查會議前二日未能提供完成註冊及第一期繳費或申請緩繳手續佐證者，一律不發給獎學金。

If proof of completed registration and first installment payment or a deferred payment application is not provided at least two days before the College of Management International Affairs Committee review meeting, the scholarship will not be granted.

4. 管理學院國際事務委員會依國際處通知本院之獎學金名額，按以下原則進行審查及分配：

- (1) 學士班、碩士班、博士班申請人數比例
- (2) 各系/所/班申請人數比例
- (3) 學業成績表現

管理學院特別提醒：囿於獎學金名額有限，無法保證申請的同學皆能獲獎。

建議同學們應妥善安排來校就讀所需費用，也希望同學們能持續在學業上努力，以獲取更高的獎學金類別。

The International Affairs Committee of the College of Management reviews and allocates scholarships in accordance with the quota provided by the Office of International Affairs, based on the following principles:

- (1) The proportion of applicants across undergraduate, master's, and doctoral programs.
- (2) The proportion of applicants from each department, institute, and program.
- (3) Academic performance.

The College of Management would like to kindly remind students that, due to the limited number of scholarship awards available, it may not be possible for every applicant to receive a scholarship.

We encourage students to make thoughtful financial preparations for your studies, and we sincerely hope you will continue your hard work and academic dedication, which will help open opportunities for higher-level scholarships in the future.
